PE and Sport Premium Spend 2021-2022 (Evidencing the Impact)

This academic year we have spent our PE and Sport Premium Funding on raising physical activity across the school.

We have purchased a **Daily Mile** track which is located on the school playground. The Daily Mile is a fantastic initiative which aims to improve the physical, emotional and wellbeing of children. Coming soon, we have a new **Adventure Frame**, which will also be situated on the playground. The climbing frame is made up of numerous obstacles, featured at different levels, that naturally raise children's enthusiasm and excitement levels. This one of a kind structure develops children's fine and gross motor skills, balance, proprioception, strength and core stability.



In addition to the above resources, we have purchased an **Orienteering and Outdoor Adventure Course**. This is a Cross-Curricular package which provides the infrastructure, resources and knowledge to support physical activity across the whole curriculum.
